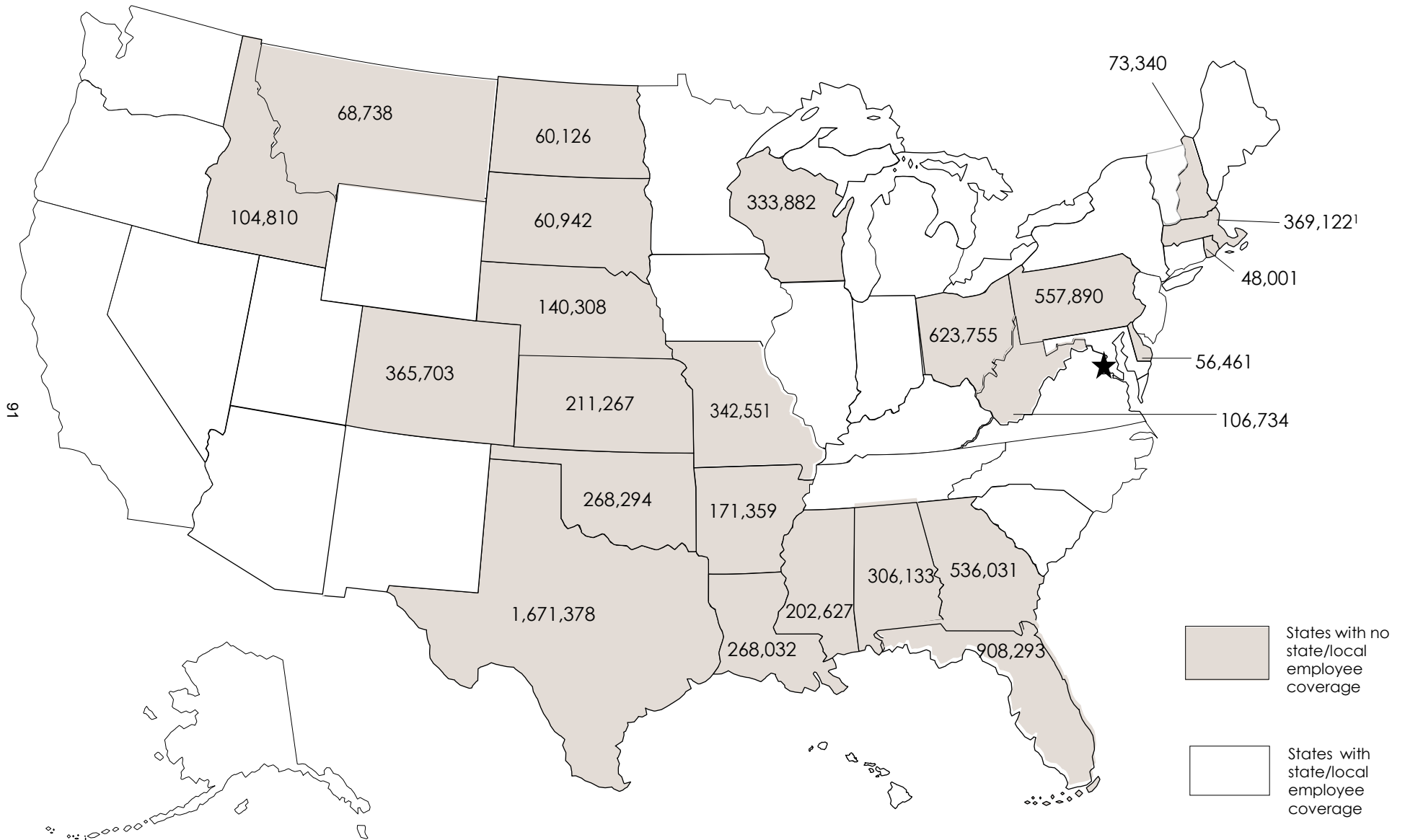


7.9 Million State and Local Employees Lacked OSHA Coverage in 2020
