- Develop and execute campaign strategies grounded in building worker power and strengthening our community partnerships.
- Assist in developing and implementing training strategy and program to build capacity for strategic research and campaigns throughout the labor movement.
- Moves AFL-CIO programs with affiliate staff and community partners. \
- Maintains relationships with AFL-CIO, affiliate union staff, community partners, outside consultants, academic, and issue activists.
- Effectively communicates AFL-CIO campaign goals to elected leadership of local and national affiliate staff.
- Plays a central role in campaign planning, including worker, political, and community elements.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
